**Fairview Cemetery**, N Halstead Rd & NW 12 Rd.  
Rebecca Keys Burch, American Revolution widow buried here.

**Halstead Cemetery & Mausoleum**, 1406 S Hertzler Rd.  
Doc Hertzler buried in cemetery and tour of mausoleum,  
11am & 2pm.

**Flood Gates**, N Path & Main. Tour at noon, meet at museum.

**Halstead Historical Museum**, 116 E First. Open 9am-4pm.  
Guided walks, 1 & 3pm

**Halstead Public Library**, 264 Main. Open 10am-1pm.

**Interurban Railroad Remnants**, Spruce St & E 2<sup>nd</sup>.  
Old railroad station and bridges. Tour at 4pm.

**Kansas Learning Center for Health**, 505 Main. Oldest rural  
health museum in the nation and famous female transparent  
mannequin. Great stop for kids. Noon-5pm.

**Post Office Art**, 319 Main. 1941 Section artwork mural by  
famed Kansas landscape artist Birger Sandzen. 24/7

**Riverside Park**, 201 Custer. Site of Old Settlers Picnic,  
suspension bridge and filming location for the movie "Picnic."

**Scout Park**, 3rd & Locust. Gazebo. Located near center of  
town has a nice picnic area, playground and restrooms.

**Springdale Art & Nature Center**, 14001 W U.S. 50. Scenic  
48 acres with art gallery, classes, outdoor sculpture and nature  
trail. Tours and demonstrations, 10am-4pm.

**Suspension Bridge**, 201 Custer. Built in 1938 over the Little  
Arkansas River and featured in the movie, "Picnic."

**Warkentine Trail**, S. Halstead Rd & Southwest 30th.  
A 1.7 mile walking path on top of the flood levee runs along  
the Little Arkansas River.

## RESTAURANTS SATURDAY HOURS

- 8AM-2PM **309 Nutrition, 309 Main.** Healthy shakes, coffees, energy teas and good vibes.
- 11AM-9PM **D'Angelo's Pizzeria**, 247 Main. Pizza, soups, salads, pastas, subs, hamburgers, and daily lunch buffet. Hopefully the ice cream machine will be fixed in time for the Pop Up!
- 8AM-6PM **Daphne Mae Cafe**, 208 Main. Coffees, breakfast & lunch in a restored historic building.

- 10AM-10PM **Ruby's Lounge**, 204 Main. Full bar and small menu in a cozy, restored historic building.
